Children's Choir *

Students in grades 3 through 8 are invited to join the Star of the Sea School Children's Choir, led by Star's Music Director, Cecilia Cardenas. Chinese Language Classes (Cantonese and Mandarin)

Kidstock, Inc Performing Arts for Children's Program allows kids to express themselves through song, dance and drama, culminating in a performance at the end of each semester for all to enjoy. No experience necessary and with Kidstock, "Everyone Shines"! (Open to students in Grades 1 – 5)

Piano

If you've ever thought of having your child take piano lessons, now they can in Star's own auditorium. Children will learn all the basics, including sight-reading, technique and theory in a group setting with Amy Norman, an 8-year music director and piano instructor.

Cost: \$85 / Month; Days & Times: Mon, 3:00 – 4:00, Beginning September 8; Venue: Star of the Sea Auditorium (Note: Private individual lessons are also available but must be scheduled with the teacher directly.)



Spanish Language Classes

In our multi-cultural world and school, these classes are a great way for students to pick up another language. Star of the Sea has enlisted the services of IES Language Foundation to provide your child with the opportunity to learn Spanish through their native bilingual speakers. Students will receive home reinforcement materials, which include curriculum for the entire program in addition to the after-school instruction. All children will receive a certificate at the end of the program.

Cost: \$740 / Semester (Installment Plan is available); Days & Times: Tue, Wed & Thu, K – 3rd Grade - 2:55 – 3:55; 4th – 8th Grade - 3:10 – 4:10; Venue: Star of the Sea School



Total Golf Adventures

Hoping your child's the next Tiger Woods? If so or if you just want your child to learn a new sport, Total Golf Adventures (TGA) is bringing golf lessons to Star! Using mats, nets and assorted props, TGA will teach solid swing fundamentals, drills and simulations.
